Rationale

- 1. To promote and encourage **Self-Directed Learning**, **Choice-Based** After-Curriculum Lessons
- 2. The remedial schedule serves as a platform to **deconflict** teachers' appointments with the same student.

Key Change

1. Reduce remedial frequency to 1 day per subject per week for 4NA/4G2 to optimise learning capacity of students as a follow-up from 2025 SMC review.

Guidelines for Subject Teachers

- 1. Department will provide a menu of remedial classes on specific topics or skills for students to sign up for the class/clinics that they need help with.
 - a) Each class/clinic/group should have about 10-15 students.
 - b) Teacher should not use "first come first serve". Teachers can choose to extend an invitation to students who need it, as a first cut, based on the WA results, with the knowledge that they are not going to take the initiative. Alternatively, invite students through their parents via PG.
 - c) The final Choice-based schedule will then reflect the clinics which have been selected, and the names of students who have successfully got their slots.
 - d) In the event that some class/clinics are over-subscribed, teachers can choose to open up more slots.
- 2. Teacher will provide extra practices online for students to follow-up with independent practice and self- assessment.
- 3. Teachers can continue to open up remedial classes on choice-basis <u>nearer the Prelims</u>, when all the content gaps have been closed.
- 4. After Prelims, teachers can open up slots for students to consult teacher based on their customized needs (for weaker topics).
- 5. Use the **Edupage App** for booking of venue.
- 6. Make alternative arrangements if there is a clash with meetings / workshops that are already scheduled in the school calendar.
